

- The OBES requires the use of person-first language and non-stigmatizing images in all written and verbal communications.
- Each abstract should only be submitted to one abstract track.
- Word limit for abstract title: 50 words.
- Word limit for abstract content: 400 words (excluding author information and field titles).
- Please organize the body of the abstract as follows:
  - Background
  - $^{\circ}$  Methods
  - $^{\circ}$  Results
  - Conclusion
- There is no limit on the number of abstracts submitted.
- Please state the preference of your submission as follows:
  - Both Oral/E-poster submission
  - E-Poster submission only
